Mehta Charitable Foundation, Lalitaben Ramniklal Shah Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Gardi Vidyapith Campus, Opp. Shiv Shakti Hotel, Kalawad Highway, Village Anandpur, Rajkot - 361162, Gujarat for Admission in BHMS Course with Intake Capacity of 100 seats and for Post Graduate Course (MD) with intake capacity of 16 seats in 04 subjects namely Organon of Medicine, Practice of Medicine, Repertory, and Homoeopathic Materia Medica with 04 seats each for academic year 2025-26- reg.

Sir/Madam,

Lalitaben Ramniklal Shah Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital has submitted an application for permission for sanction of 100 seats in BHMS course and for Post Graduate Course (MD) with intake capacity of total 16 seats in 04 subjects namely Organon of Medicine, Practice of Medicine, Repertory, and Homoeopathic Materia Medica with 04 seats each for the academic year 2025-26. MARBH conducted Inspection on 26.06.2025 and 27.06.2025, followed by virtual hearing 15.07.2025. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls:

- A. Teaching Faculty:** Deficiencies observed in teaching faculty are as below:
- Principal also holds the post of Professor, Community Medicine which is not as per MES, 2024 Regulations.
 - Physiology Department: Professor 01 not available.
 - Practice of Medicine Department: Associate Professor 01 not available.
 - Practice of Medicine Department (PG): Professor 01 and Associate Professor 01 not available.
 - University approved Guide list not available

As evident from the above statement, a total number of three teachers are deficient against the requirement of 40+1 for 100 seats UG college (As specified in MES, 2024). Pursuant to F.No. :3-2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dtd. 16/04/2025 issued by MARBH, a college can avail 10% relaxation against the required number of teachers for academic year 2025-26 only. After allowing relaxation of 10%, college has no deficiency of teachers. However, such a relaxed number of teachers should also be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course

B. Hospital Functioning:

- Pharmacist 03 not available.
- Labor room is non-functioning.
- Emergency unit is non-functional.
- OPD/IPD needs improvement.
- IPD is on 1st floor. Lift and Ramp facility not available in hospital.

C. Teaching Department: Community Department: Department area is not as per MES, 2024 Regulations.

D. Miscellaneous:

- a) NABH accreditation not available for hospital.
- b) NABL accreditation not available for laboratory.

2. Considering the above observations during inspection and virtual hearing, MARBH has decided to issue **conditional permission to Smt. T.V. Mehta Charitable Foundation, Lalitaben Ramniklal Shah Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Gardi Vidyapith Campus, Opp. Shiv Shakti Hotel, Kalawad Highway, Village Anandpur, Rajkot - 361162, Gujarat for Admission in BHMS Course with Intake Capacity of 100 seats for the academic year 2025-26 on basis of following conditions:**

- i. Hospital shall be functioning as per MES, 2024 Regulations.
- ii. Principal shall not hold any post, other than Principal.
- iii. Community Department shall be as per MES, 2024.
- iv. University approved Guide list shall be submitted.
- v. NABH and NABL accreditation shall be available at earliest.

Deficiencies mentioned above shall be rectified within a period of 30 days and the compliance report shall be submitted to the undersigned, failing which conditional permission issued will be withdrawn without further notice

3. Considering the post-graduation faculty available, MARBH has decided to issue **permission to Smt. T.V. Mehta Charitable Foundation, Lalitaben Ramniklal Shah Homoeopathic Medical College & Hospital, Gardi Vidyapith Campus, Opp. Shiv Shakti Hotel, Kalawad Highway, Village Anandpur, Rajkot - 361162, Gujarat for Admission in Post Graduate Course (MD) with intake capacity of 13 seats (reduced from 16) in 04 subjects namely Organon of Medicine with 04 seats, Practice of Medicine with 01 seat (reduced from 04), Repertory with 04 seats, and Homoeopathic Materia Medica with 04 seats for the academic year 2025-26**

4. All admissions shall be made from NEET/AIAPGET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats and post graduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of UG/PG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. Counselling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective Counselling Authority of State/UT govt as designated by Central Government and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counselling authority of the state/UT.

5. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board

6. If the College is aggrieved by any decision of the Autonomous Board, college may prefer an appeal to the Commission against such decision within 30 days of the communication of such decision as per National Commission for Homoeopathy (Assessment and Rating of Medical Institutions) Regulations 2024, section 14 subsection (1) and NCH General Regulation 2023 'section 22. The Manner of instructions for appeal are attached
