started his practice in sales tax and income tax.

Dipchandbhai since childhood had dreamt to help the society through various activities. He always prayed to his deity to give him strength to donate Rupees 1000 every month for social causes.

'Decision determine destiny'. This saying was proved true by Dipchandbhai. At the age of 98 he is still donating thousand of rupees every month.

He donates mainly towards health and education. Though Dipchandbhai left

Padadhri and settled Mumbai years back, he has still maintained his connections with Padadhri. So far he has constructed more than 10 schools and high schools in Padadhri and its periphery.

Former Sarpanch of Padadhri Dr. G. L. Vasani fondly says," people of Padadhri are proud that he belongs to our town. His 76th birthday was celebrated with pomp here. A mass kitchen was organized and renowned families like Ambani and Tata's came here to attend the ceremony."

Dipchandbhai strongly believes that every penny he saves can be used for charity. He himself lives a very simple life and avoids wasting money.

"It is difficult to find a person like Dipchandbhai. Everybody lives for himself, but he lives for others. To donate the entire income is very difficult, but he is doing this extraordinary thing every day." Dr. Vasani added.

# Night School;

November, 1906. The thought of a night school first occurred to Prince Ganeshnarayan Parjaye who came to Rajkot to complete his formal education at the Rajkumar College. To educate his servants and their children he decided to start this school.

Initially it was a part of Saurashtra High School which later became a part of Karansinhji High School and the institute had papers that were taught in Oxford University. Fees at those times were just 25 paisa and today anybody above the age of 75yrs is given free education. Due to unavoidable circumstances Karansinhji School was closed down. But to continue with the night school it started in 2005 under the name of 'Dharmarth Vidyalaya'. Trustee of this institution is


