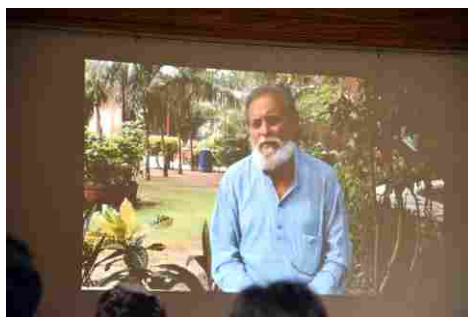
B. H. Gardi College of Engineering & Technology has organized **HR meet** on 24th May 2013 at **Hotel St. Lurn, Ahmedabad**.

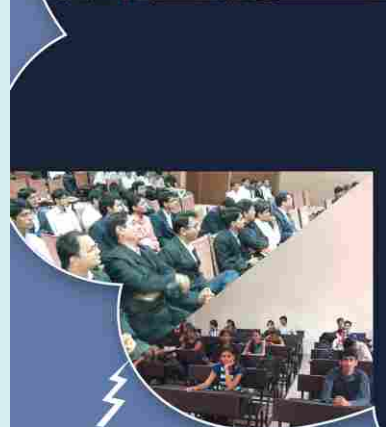

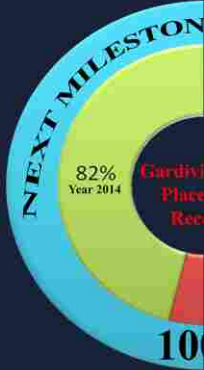
